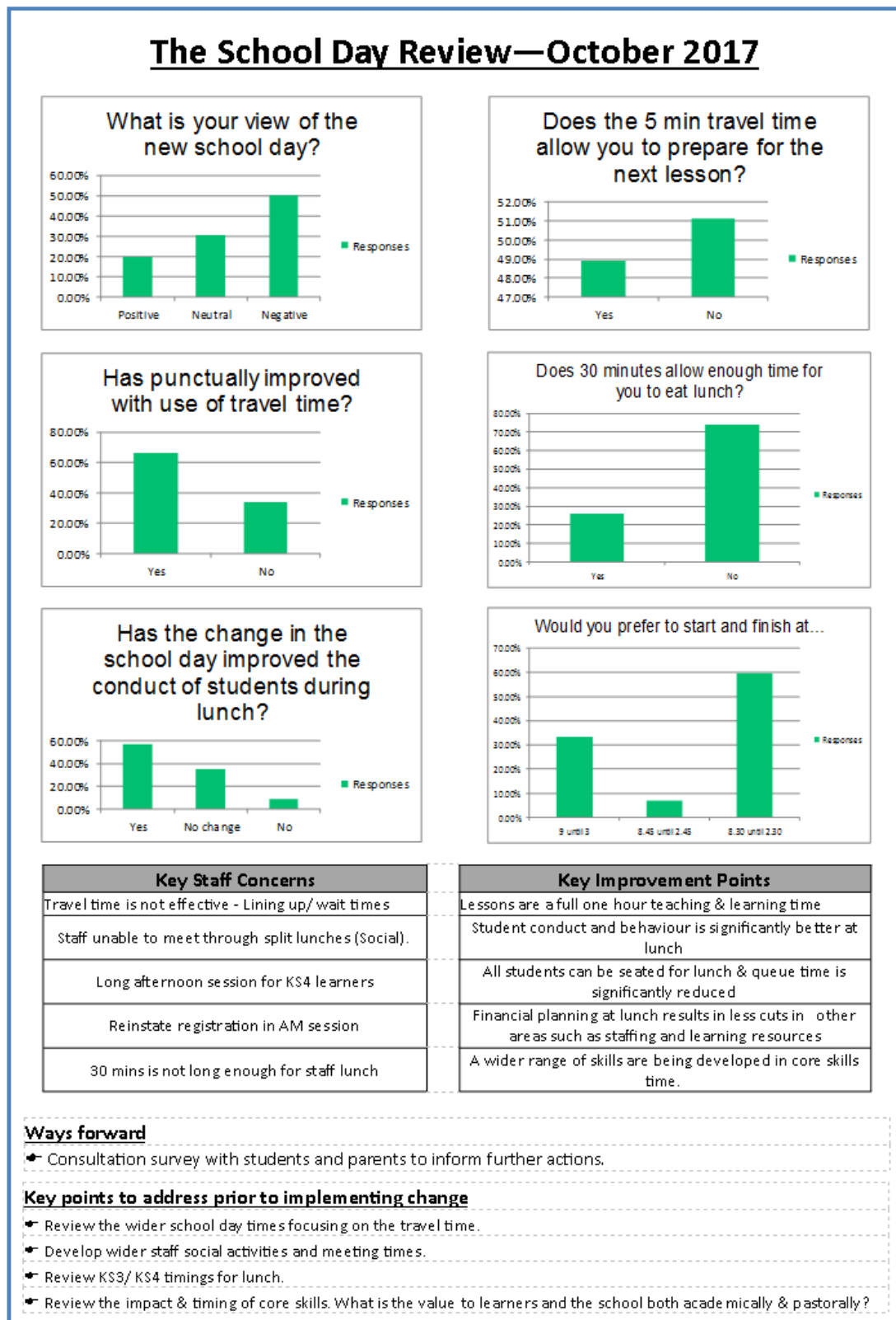


## School Day Consultation

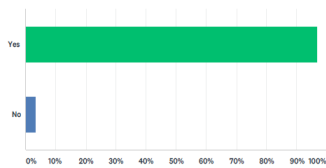

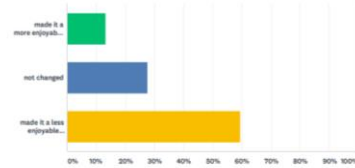

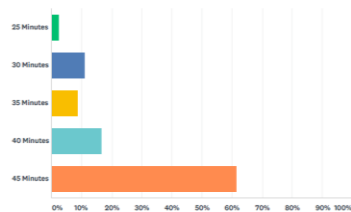

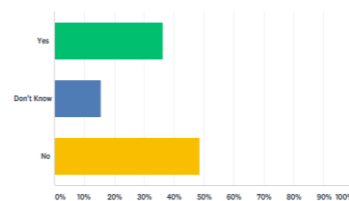

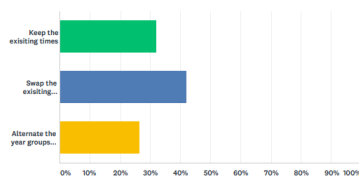

- Students clearly wish to start earlier and end earlier.
- Travel time appears to be more popular with younger students.
- Students appear not to be on time in the survey response, but lesson marks/ monitor does not support this view.
- All Year groups wish to take the later lunch break.
- Students would rather have longer for lunch.

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## Proposed Developments

- ✓ Swap the KS3 and KS4 lunch around. Sixth Form Students to remain at the same time.
- ✓ Lunch is 35 mins, as each includes a travel time; therefore formalise this as lunch. Look to reduce travel time in longer term developments.
- ✓ Develop use of electronic communication for student/parent/ teacher dialogue.
- ✓ Address inclement weather issue with shoes; student off grassed areas into halls and hard standing areas.
- ✓ Report to GB in the Headteacher's report queue times and food options.
- ✓ Open a wider review in the spring term for a review of the start/ end time of School.
