ENGLISH

Any movement for Year 10 moving into 11 in September will be based on the GCSE English Literature grade secured in the summer along with teachers' professional judgement where appropriate.

MATHEMATICS

Year 9

Set 1 will sit a higher tier GCSE exam

Sets 2 to 5 will sit an intermediate tier GCSE exam Sets 6 and 7 will sit a foundation tier GCSE exam

The results of these combined with teachers' professional judgement will determine any class changes for September.

Year 10

Set 2 will sit a higher tier GCSE exam paper.

Sets 3 to 7 will sit an intermediate tier GCSE exam. These exams will form part of the evidence to help us determine which tier students should be entered for in the November GCSE Mathematics examinations.

SCIENCE

Year 9

Year 9 will be having a test on the first 3 units that they have covered of the GCSE course:

- 1) Cells and transport (Biology)
- 2) Ever changing earth (Chemistry)
- 3) Making use of energy (Physics)

Revision notes can be found in the Bangor revision guides which are available in Google Classroom.

Year 10

The Year 10 Science classes will be reset at the start of Year 11 based on their GCSE Science results.

The results of these combined with teachers' professional judgment will determine any class changes for September.
