There is no cost for this trip and transport will be provided. **Lunch and dinner are also provided**, therefore pupils **will not need** to bring any packed lunch.

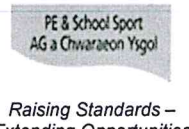

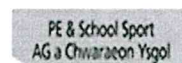
