RE: DRAFT NATIONAL CATEGORISATION

In addition to our good Estyn Inspection in May 2019, which can be found by following this link <u>https://www.estyn.gov.wales/provider/st-martin-school</u>, I am delighted to inform you that St. Martin's School has been categorised as a "Green" school by the Welsh Government following the latest round of national school categorisation.

There are two distinct steps in categorising each school. Schools will be grouped A - D for its capacity for improvement (A – most capacity for improvement, with D - least); and green through to yellow, amber and red for the level of support/intervention required (green - least intervention required, with red - most). The National Categorisation has identified St. Martin's School as:

- Group A school for its track record of 'capacity over time'; and
- Green school for the level of support required.
