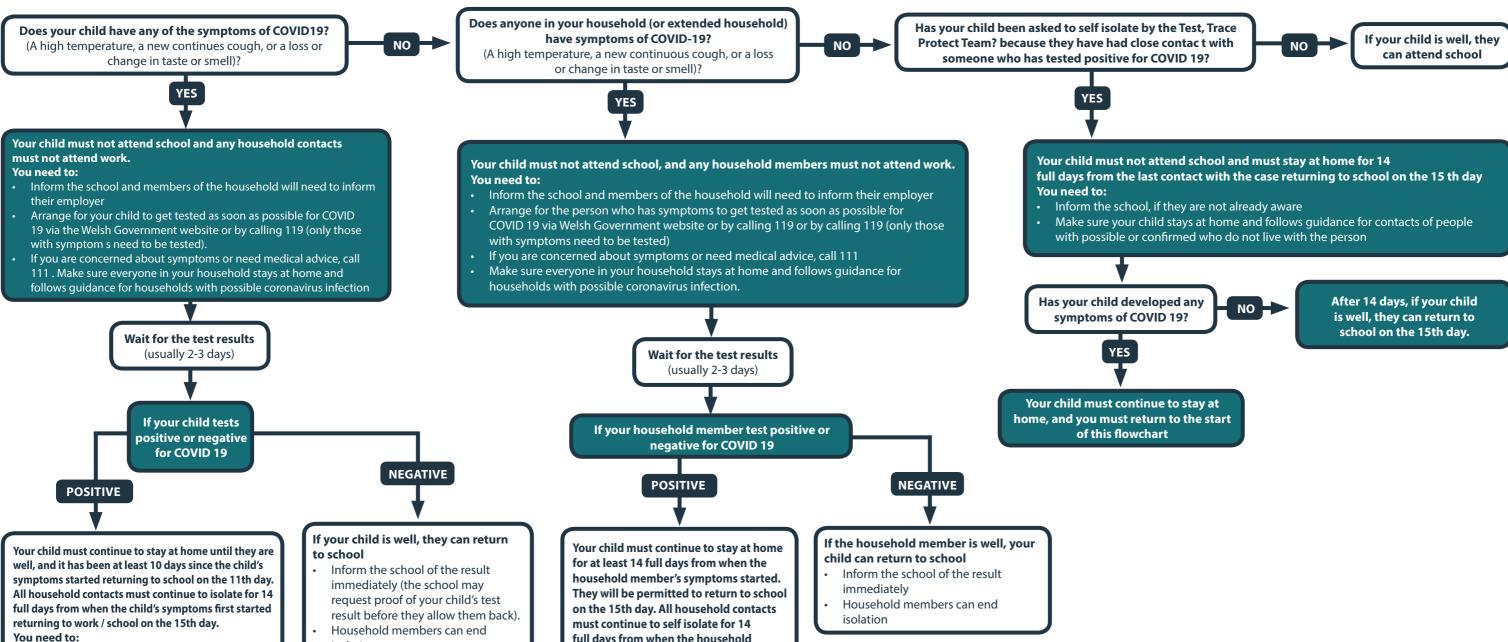
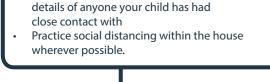


## FLOWCHART FOR PARENTS:

## What to do if someone has symptoms of COVID 19 or has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID 19







Inform the school of the results

Continue to make sure everyone in your

household stays at home and follows

Prepare to be contacted by the Test,

guidance for households with possible

Trace, Protect (TTP) team and to provide

immediately

coronavirus infection.

After 10 full days, if your child is well, and has been free from a fever for 48hrs they can return to school on the 11th day.

isolation

Please note: If you r child or household member has been asked to self isolate by the test trace protect team, they must continue to do this even if they receive a negative test result.

full days from when the household contact's symptoms started. You need to:

- Inform the school
- Continue to make sure everyone in your household stays at home and follows guidance for households with possible coronavirus infection.
- Prepare to be contacted by the Test Trace Protect team and to provide details of anyone the positive household member has had close contact with.
- Practice social distancing within the house wherever possible
