Identifying and supporting Young Carers at St Martin's School.

At St Martin's School we are aware that some of our pupils are young carers.

A young carer is someone under 18 who is caring, unpaid, for a family member, or friend, who is mentally or physically unwell, frail, disabled or who misuses substances.

They often take on practical and/or emotional caring responsibilities that would normally be expected of an adult.

Research suggests that there are **at least** 800,000 young carers in the UK but many do not realise they are a young carer. This means there could be 6 young carers in a class of 30.

We know that young carers may need a little extra support to enjoy and do well at school. At St Martin's, we are committed to ensuring that all pupils who are young carers are identified, and supported effectively.

As the Young Carer's Lead (Mrs L Jolliffe) I have a responsibility for ensuring all young carers are able to enjoy school and make good progress. If you think your child might be a young carer, or could be affected by any of the issues we've highlighted, please let me know by filling in the form below and returning it to school in a sealed envelope addressed to me.
